EXHIBIT VENUE: ANDERSON ART CENTER

The Anderson Arts Center, a 9,000 square foot mansion built in 1892 as a private residence, showcases the work of a variety of local, regional and national artists. The large, open expanses of wall space now lend themselves perfectly to the display of artwork. Its location between Milwaukee and Chicago attracts audiences from both regions. Museum hours are: Tuesday through Sunday from 1:00 - 4:00 p.m. The Wisconsin Artists Biennial proudly returns to this attractive venue.



Continuing its commitment to all Wisconsin artists, Wisconsin Visual Artists (WVA) sponsors and organizes the Wisconsin Artists Biennial, a state wide fine arts competition open to all visual artists in the state of Wisconsin. This year the Anderson Art Center will host and co-sponsor the exhibition. Exhibition management is being conducted by the WVA Biennial Committee.

ELIGIBILITY AND RESTRICTIONS

Original work can be in any media executed 2009 or later by residents of Wisconsin, 18 years or older. No giclee' prints of artists' original watercolors or oils are acceptable. Only giclee's and prints created by an artist's own hands in signed and limited numbers are acceptable.

ENTRY

- Fees are non-refundable:
Students with proof of student status—\$20.00;
WVA members—\$25.00; non-members—\$35.00
- Two works per artist may be submitted, with only one image of each work, regardless of medium.
- Work will be selected for the exhibition from jpegs on CD's. Awards, however, will be chosen by viewing the actual pieces when in the Anderson Arts Center. See image entry details in Checklist.
- Works are insured while on the premises of the Anderson Arts Center. Liability during delivery to and pick-up from the Anderson Arts Center is the responsibility of the artist.
- Works on paper must be framed and wired for hanging unless otherwise stipulated by the artist. In the event the work is not under protective cover, the Anderson Arts Center and WVA will not be held responsible for any marks or other alterations to the work that may occur.
- Maximum dimensions for hanging pieces are 5' X 5'; and maximum hanging weight is 50 lbs. 3-D work has to fit through an approximately 6' double doorway entry space.
- The WVA Biennial Committee will help connect accepted artists to assist them in making artwork delivery and pick up arrangements. It will be the responsibility of the artists to work out the details with one another for 'carpooling' the artwork.
- Work requiring unusual handling and/or installation is the responsibility of the artist to move and install with the help of gallery staff.

- WVA reserves the right to decline any work deemed by the jurors to not accurately reflect the image submitted for entry.

AWARDS

- A minimum of \$1500 in prize money and merchandise will be awarded.
- The Anderson Arts Center will retain a 40% commission for sales of art.

SELECTION & AWARDS JUROR

Ellen Lanyon will select the work for the 2011 Wisconsin Artist Biennial from the jpegs that are entered (all names will be replaced with a number) and an Excel document with work specifics. Lanyon will make every effort to select the awards from the actual work once it is at the Anderson Art Center.

- ___ Up to three digital images may be submitted on CD. **Emailed entries are not allowed.** Please follow digital entry guidelines: All images must be in JPEG format, RGB color space and no larger than 1200 pixels in any dimension. Each image file must be named with last-name_firstname_01 / lastname_firstname_02. Do not place artist's name within the digital image file. Juror will not be given any names for the submitted works. **Put your name on the CD.** Juror will not handle individual CDs.
- ___ Color or B/W printouts of your submitted entries must be included with your entry and the images must match the digital file submitted. Include artists name, title of work, medium and dimensions on the printout for each work submitted. These are used for cross-reference and as safeguard only
- ___ Enclose appropriate entry fee made out to WVA (see Entry guidelines)
- ___ S.A.S.E for return of the notification form. If you want your CD returned please label it 'Return CD' and make sure your S.A.S.E. is large enough and has sufficient postage for return of CD and notification.
- ___ Send the above to Wisconsin Artists Biennial 2011, P.O. Box 511334, Milwaukee, WI 53203.
- ___ Labels must accompany accepted work at time of drop-off but should not be attached.

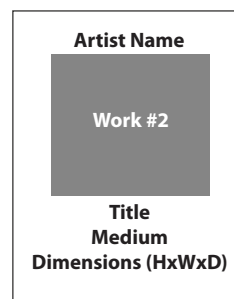
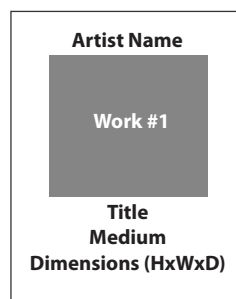
